AN ACT TO PROVIDE A CLOTHING ALLOWANCE FOR EMPLOYEES OF

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 All employees in the institutions in the departments of mental
2 and public health, who are required to wear uniforms in per-
3 formance of their duties, shall be paid the following clothing
4 allowance: male employees, seventy-five cents per week; fe-
5 male employees, one dollar per week, to be paid quarterly.
