AN ACT EXTENDING THE TERM FOR WHICH THE INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF BUILDINGS WAS APPOINTED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
- 2 the term of office of the incumbent, on the date of the passage
- 3 of this act, of the office of state superintendent of buildings shall
- 4 be five years from the date on which he was appointed.

## The Commission of Enquiry

---

In the House of Representatives

---

1. That the Commission of Enquiry be constituted as follows:
2. That the Commission be empowered to inquire into the administration of the Department of the Interior, and to report thereon to the House of Representatives.
3. That the Commission be authorized to call for and examine any records, papers, or documents in the possession of the Department of the Interior, or of any officer or agent thereof, and to take such evidence as it may deem proper.
4. That the Commission be authorized to hold public hearings, and to receive testimony from any person who may be called upon to give it.
5. That the Commission be authorized to employ such clerical and other personnel as it may deem necessary, and to fix their compensation.
6. That the Commission be authorized to make such contracts as may be necessary for the proper conduct of its business.
7. That the Commission be authorized to report to the House of Representatives at such time and in such manner as it may deem proper.
8. That the Commission be authorized to do all such other and sundry things as may be necessary and proper to carry out the purposes of this act.
