RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE REFUND OF CERTAIN EXCISE TAXES PAID BY ALGER BROTHERS, INC.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral obliga-
2 tion of the commonwealth and after an appropriation has been
3 made therefor, there shall be allowed and paid out of the state
4 treasury to Alger Brothers, Inc. the sum of twelve thousand, six
5 hundred and twenty-three dollars and twenty-four cents, which
6 is the amount of the refund which said corporation would have
7 received if it had seasonably filed a claim for the refund of excise
8 tax paid by it on motor vehicle fuel acquired within and used
9 outside of the commonwealth.
