## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR NOTICE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAKING  
BY EMINENT DOMAIN BY THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1947 is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after the word "defined", in line 15, the following: —  
3 provided, that before any real estate shall be so taken, thirty  
4 days' notice of intention to make such taking shall be given to  
5 the mayor or city manager of each city and to the selectmen of  
6 each town in which said taking is proposed.
