AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN AMOUNTS OF CONTRIBUTORY GROUP LIFE AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE FOR PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 5 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following:—

4 *Section 5.* The amount of group life insurance on each em-
5 ployee shall be four thousand dollars, and the amount of group
6 accidental death and dismemberment insurance on each em-
7 ployee shall be four thousand dollars. The amount of the
8 hospital, surgical and medical benefits to be provided each
9 employee and his dependents shall be determined by the com-
10 mission subject to the provisions of section four.
