By Mr. Costello of Boston, petition of John W. Costello relative to assistance in the rehabilitation of employees who receive injuries arising out of or in the course of their employment. Labor and Industries.

AN ACT TO ASSIST IN THE REHABILITATION OF EMPLOYEES WHO RECEIVE INJURIES ARISING OUT OF AND IN THE COURSE OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of rehabilitation of injured employees where
2 compensation for total incapacity under section thirty-four has
3 been paid under an agreement as provided by section six, a
4 finding of a single member or of a review board, or decree of the
5 superior or the supreme judicial court, such agreement, finding
6 or decree shall be construed, in the event the employee attempts
7 to work or continues to work in limited capacity due to his
8 injury at his former employment or other employment to also
9 provide that partial compensation for partial incapacity as
10 provided by this section shall be due and paid in accordance
11 with his earnings while so employed.

12 The provisions of the foregoing sentence shall be enforceable
13 as provided in section eleven.
