AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO PROVIDE LIFEGUARDS AT REVERE BEACH AND WINTHROP BEACH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to provide lifeguards at Revere
- 3 beach and Winthrop beach to protect the public.

The House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress assembled, do hereby pass the following bill, which the Senate has concurred in, with amendments, and the President has approved.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT APPROVED MARCH TWENTY-NINE LAST, RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, February 27, 1901.
