### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPELLATE TAX BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 58A of the General Laws, as amended,  
2 is hereby further amended by striking out the first paragraph  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following:—  
4 *Section 1. Establishment; Appointment; Terms; Compensation.* There shall be in the department of corporations and tax-  
5 ation but in no manner subject to the control of the said depart-  
6 ment, an appellate tax board, in this chapter referred to as the  
7 board, consisting of eight members appointed by the governor,  
8 with the advice and consent of the council. The governor, with  
9 the advice and consent of the council, shall designate one of the  
10 members as chairman. Upon the expiration of the term of  
11 office of a member, his successor shall be appointed in the  
12 manner aforesaid for eight years. The chairman of said board  
13 shall receive a salary of eleven thousand dollars and each other  
14 member shall receive a salary of ten thousand dollars. All  
15 members of the board shall devote their whole time in office  
16 17 hours to the work of the board.
