AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF LAND BY THE NEW BEDFORD, WOODS HOLE, MARTHA'S VINEYARD AND NANTUCKET STEAMSHIP AUTHORITY BY EMINENT DOMAIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1948 is hereby amended
2 by inserting after paragraph (h) the following paragraph:—

3 (i) The authority may from time to time acquire by eminent
4 domain under chapter seventy-nine or by purchase, lease or
5 otherwise, any lands necessary or desirable for its purposes,
6 and may lay out and maintain such lands for such purposes and
7 erect and maintain such structures and other facilities thereon
8 as may be necessary and desirable for such purposes; provided,
9 however, that no land held in trust for public use shall be taken
10 by eminent domain.

The Commission of Grand Jurors
