## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

AN ACT PROTECTING CERTAIN RIGHTS OF PERSONS FILING CANCELLATION COMPLAINTS RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary,  
2 no person who files a cancellation complaint, under the provisions  
3 of section one hundred and thirteen D of chapter one hundred  
4 and seventy-five of the General Laws, shall be denied, irrespec-  
5 tive of the findings on such complaint by the board of appeal,  
6 any rights to which he would have otherwise been entitled had  
7 he not filed such a complaint.
