

Chap. 62. AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW LIMITING THE NUMBER OF SIGNATURES OF VOTERS OF ANY ONE COUNTY ON STATE-WIDE RECOUNT PETITIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The third paragraph of section 135 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 353 of the acts of 1947, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 7 and 8, the words: — , not less than two hundred and fifty to be from each of four different counties.

Chap. 63. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE CERTIFICATION OF SIGNATURES ON NOMINATION PAPERS AND INITIATIVE PETITIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 7 of chapter 53 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

Signatures shall not be certified on nomination papers or initiative and referendum petitions from more than one city or town per sheet.

Chap. 64. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BEVERLY TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN THE CITY OF BEVERLY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The city of Beverly, by its mayor, is hereby authorized to convey, without monetary consideration, by a deed approved as to form by the city solicitor of said city, to the commonwealth two parcels of land in said city shown as Parcel "C" and Parcel "D" on a plan entitled "Plan of Land Located in the Vicinity of Norwoods Pond, Beverly, Mass., Scale: One inch equals One Hundred feet April One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One, Edgar G. Mitchell, 'Acting Commissioner of Public Works' (Note: Revised-June Fourteenth, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two)," said plan being on file in the city engineer's office at city hall in said city and bounded and described as follows:—

PARCEL "C"

South Forty-Seven Degrees, Eight Minutes, Thirty Seconds East by land of Carnevale, Two Hundred Nine and Seventy-Seven One Hundredths Feet. South Eighty-Six Degrees, Forty-Four Minutes, Zero Seconds East, by land of Carnevale, Three Hundred Six and Thirty-Two One Hundredths Feet. North Eleven Degrees, Four Minutes, Forty Seconds West by land of Carnevale, Two Hundred Ninety-Five and Thirty-Seven One Hundredths Feet. North Forty

Degrees, Seventeen Minutes, Ten Seconds West, by land of Carnevale, One Hundred Fifty-Eight and Eighty-Four One Hundredths Feet. South Forty-Four Degrees, Eight Minutes, Fifty Seconds East, by land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Three Hundred One and Twenty-Five One Hundredths Feet. South Nine Degrees, One Minute, Thirty Seconds East by land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Two Hundred Eleven and Eighty One Hundredths Feet. South Thirty-Seven Degrees Twenty Minutes, Twenty Seconds East by land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, One Hundred Fifty-Two and Eleven One Hundredths Feet. South Four Degrees, Thirty-Six Minutes, Twenty Seconds West, by land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Four Hundred Forty-Nine and Fifty-One One Hundredths Feet. South Fifty-Seven Degrees, Forty-Three Minutes, Twenty-Two Seconds West, by land of Moses G. Brudno, Bernice E. Brudno, Sally B. Wyner, Trustee, Seven Hundred Twenty-Eight and Twenty-Eight One Hundredths Feet. North Thirty-Two Degrees, One Minute, Zero Seconds West, by land of the City of Beverly, (Parcel "D"), One Hundred Seventy-Six Feet. North Twenty-Nine Degrees, Forty-Eight Minutes, Ten Seconds West, by land of the City of Beverly, (Parcel "D"), One Hundred Seventy-Three and Sixty-Seven One Hundredths Feet. North Thirty-Three Degrees, Thirty-Three Minutes, Forty Seconds West, by land of the City of Beverly, (Parcel "D"), One Hundred Twenty and Seventeen One Hundredths Feet. North Thirty-Two Degrees, Eight Minutes, Forty Seconds West, by land of the City of Beverly, (Parcel "D"), One Hundred Fifty and Sixty-Seven One Hundredths Feet. North Thirty-Two Degrees, Fifty-Six Seconds, Ten Seconds West, by land of the City of Beverly, (Parcel "D"), Two Hundred Eight and Forty-Eight One Hundredths Feet. North Thirty-One Degrees, Thirty-Two Minutes, Ten Seconds West, by land of the City of Beverly, (Parcel "D"), Thirty and Sixty-Four One Hundredths Feet.

Containing about Sixteen and Two Tenths Acres.

PARCEL "D"

Beginning at a point marked "A" on the aforementioned plan; said point "A" being located on the extension of the northeasterly line of Berrywood Lane, One Hundred feet from the southerly corner of Lot "C" being land belonging to Katz, thence running North Fifty-Nine Degrees, Twenty-Three Minutes, Three Seconds East by land of the City of Beverly, a distance of Eighty-Three and Ninety-Eight One Hundredths feet to a point marked "B" on said plan, thence turning and running South Thirty-One Degrees, Fifty-Six Minutes, Fifty-Three Seconds East by land of Carnevale, a distance of Two Hundred Seventy-Five and Fifteen One Hundredths Feet to a point marked "C" on said plan, thence running South Thirty-One Degrees, Thirty-Two Minutes, Ten Seconds East by land of Carnevale and Brudno,

Wyner, Trustees a distance of One Hundred Thirty and Sixty-Four One Hundredths feet to a point marked "D" on said plan, thence running South Thirty-Two Degrees, Fifty-Six Minutes, Ten Seconds East by land of Brudno and Wyner Trustees, a distance of Two Hundred Eight and Forty-Eight One Hundredths Feet to a point marked "E" on said plan, thence running South Thirty-Two Degrees, Eight Minutes, Forty Seconds East by land of Brudno and Wyner Trustees, a distance of One Hundred Twenty and Seventeen One Hundredths feet to a point marked "G" on said plan, thence running South Twenty-Nine Degrees, Forty-Eight Minutes, Ten Seconds East by land of Brudno and Wyner, Trustees, a distance of One Hundred Seventy-Three and Sixty-Seven One Hundredths Feet, to a point marked "H" on said plan, thence running South Thirty-Two Degrees, One Minute, Zero Seconds East by land of Brudno and Wyner, Trustees, a distance of One Hundred Seventy-Six Feet to a point marked "I" on said plan, thence turning and running South Fifty-Seven Degrees, Thirty-Three Minutes, Fifty Seconds West by land of the City of Beverly, a distance of Three Hundred Fifty Feet to a point marked "J" on said plan, thence turning and running North Thirty-One Degrees, Fifty-Seven Minutes, Twenty Seconds West by land of the City of Beverly, a distance of One Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Five and Thirty-Four One Hundredths Feet to a point marked "K" on said plan, thence turning and running North Fifty-Nine Degrees, Twenty-Three Minutes, Three Seconds East, by land of the City of Beverly and the extension of Berrywood Lane, a distance of Two Hundred Sixty-Six and Two One Hundredths Feet to the point of beginning marked "A" upon said plan.

Chap. 65. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE PLAZA TO BE CONSTRUCTED AT THE JOHN W. MCCORMACK STATE OFFICE BUILDING AS THE EDWARD H. ROEMER MEMORIAL PLAZA.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The plaza to be constructed at the John W. McCormack State Office Building shall, upon its completion, be designated and known as the Edward H. Roemer Memorial plaza, in memory of Edward H. Roemer, former three-term chairman of the government center commission. Said commission shall erect a suitable marker bearing said designation at said plaza.
