### AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR UNLAWFUL TAKING OF FISH FROM CERTAIN WATERS OF NANTUCKET SOUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 66 of the acts of 1931, as amended by  
2 chapter 59 of the acts of 1932, is hereby amended by striking  
3 out, in the second line, the words "twenty-five nor more than  
4 fifty" and inserting in place thereof the words, — five hundred  
5 nor more than one thousand, — so as to read as follows:—  
6 *Section 2.* Violation of this act shall be punished by a fine of not  
7 less than five hundred nor more than one thousand dollars.

As the Same May Be Amended

As the President and Vice-President are elected by the people of the United States, it is necessary that the mode of their election should be such as to secure the confidence of the whole people.

It is therefore proposed that the mode of electing the President and Vice-President be changed, and that the electors be chosen in the following manner:
