AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A STUDY BY THE MASS TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION OF THE TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES IN THE TOWN OF READING AREA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Mass Transportation Commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to investigate and study transportation facilities
3 affecting the town of Reading area. The commission shall make
4 a report with such recommendations as it may deem advisable
5 to the governor and the general court on or before the first day
6 of March in the current year. The commission may expend for
7 such purpose such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Conference on the Thirtieth day of February, A. D. 1887.

SECTION 1. The Board of Registration of the Commonwealth is hereby authorized and directed to investigate and report to the Senate and House of Representatives, at their next annual session, the manner in which the laws relating to the registration of voters are being executed, and to recommend such amendments to the laws as may be necessary to improve the same.
