By Mr. Craven of Boston, petition of James J. Craven, Jr., that the Metropolitan District Commission be directed to construct and maintain a recreation area in the vicinity of the Arnold Arboretum in the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF A RECREATION AREA IN THE CITY OF BOSTON IN THE VICINITY OF THE ARNOLD ARBORETUM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to construct and maintain a recreation area, with
3 suitable structures and facilities, in the city of Boston on avail-
4 able vacant land in the vicinity of the Arnold Arboretum,
5 bounded by South and Bussey streets and adjacent to the rail-
6 road. For the purpose of this act, such commission may expend
7 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

AN ACT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGEWAYS
 OF THE COMMONWEALTH, AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BOARD OF
 SUPERVISORS OF THE PUBLIC WORKS, AND THE APPOINTMENT OF
 COMMISSIONERS OF THE PUBLIC WORKS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Council,
 the 12th day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and sixty-eight.

Section 1. The several boards of supervisors in the several
 counties of the Commonwealth, and the several boards of
 supervisors of the public works in the several counties,
 shall be continued until the 1st day of January, 1870, and
 until their successors are appointed.
