RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PARKING AREA OVER THE NEPONSET RIVER IN THE MATTAPAN DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to the advisability and feasibility of constructing a
4 parking area over the Neponset river in the Mattapan district
5 of the city of Boston so as to provide parking facilities for the
6 Mattapan business district extending from the Mattapan bridge
7 to a point opposite Edgewater drive. Said commission shall,
8 in the course of its investigation and study, consider the feasi-
9 bility of constructing such parking area on piles or stanchions
10 so that the flow of said river will not be obstructed. Said com-
11 mission may expend such funds as may be appropriated therefor.
12 Said commission shall report the results of its investigation and
13 study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of
14 legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect,
15 by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives
16 on or before April first in the current year.
