## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

AN ACT ABOLISHING THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF MEDICINE AND VESTING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF SAID BOARD IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of general or  
2 special law to the contrary, all the duties and powers presently  
3 vested in the board of registration of medicine shall vest in the  
4 department of public health.

1 SECTION 2. Upon the effective date of this act, all employees,  
2 other than members of said board, shall become employees of  
3 said department without impairment of their civil service rights,  
4 if any, or their retirement, seniority, vacation, holiday or sick  
5 leave rights; and in no case shall the salary of any such employee  
6 be reduced below the amount of his salary immediately prior to  
7 said effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 3. Sections ten and eleven of chapter thirteen of the  
2 General Laws are hereby repealed.
