*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives.*

The above-named petition was transmitted to me by the Clerk of the House of Representatives on December 16, 1959, with a request for a memorandum.

The University of Massachusetts Building Association was originally organized and chartered in 1939 (chapter 388) as the Massachusetts College Building Association. It assumed its present title in 1947 and a certificate was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on August 18, 1947.

The petition with its accompanying bill seeks authority to hold, for the purposes set forth in chapter 388 of the Acts of 1939, real and personal estate of an amount not exceeding four million five hundred thousand dollars, in addition to the amount of real and personal estate previously authorized under other acts.

This Department feels that the subject matter of this petition is within the purview of the General Court.

The purposes sought to be accomplished under the said petition cannot be effected under the General Laws.

No fee is required to be paid by a corporation of this type.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE HOLDING OF PROPERTY BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS BUILDING ASSOCIATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 University of Massachusetts Building Association, incor-  
2 porated under the name of Massachusetts State College Building  
3 Association by section one of chapter three hundred and eighty-  
4 eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-nine, is hereby  
5 authorized to hold, for the purposes set forth in said chapter,  
6 real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding four million  
7 five hundred thousand dollars, in addition to the amount of  
8 real and personal estate which may be held by said corporation  
9 under authority of said chapter and of chapter three hundred  
10 and ninety of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-five,  
11 chapter three hundred and fifty-two of the acts of nineteen  
12 hundred and forty-six, chapter one hundred and eighty-five  
13 of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-eight, chapter four  
14 hundred and fourteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty,  
15 chapter two hundred and eleven of the acts of nineteen hundred  
16 and fifty-two, chapter three hundred and fifty-six of the acts of  
17 nineteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter four hundred of the  
18 acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-four, chapter four hundred  
19 and forty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-five,  
20 chapter five hundred and seventeen of the acts of nineteen  
21 hundred and fifty-seven and chapter four hundred and fifty-six  
22 of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-eight. The amount of  
23 real and personal estate now or hereafter held by said corpora-  
24 tion under authority hereof and of said chapters and of acts

25 hereafter amending or supplementing said chapter three hundred  
26 and eighty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-nine  
27 shall be measured by the principal amount of the bonds from  
28 time to time issued by said corporation under authority of  
29 section seven of chapter three hundred and eighty-eight of the  
30 acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-nine without regard to the  
31 proceeds heretofore or hereafter received by said corporation  
32 from the sale of bonds so issued or to the real or personal estate  
33 heretofore or hereafter acquired by said corporation upon  
34 application of such proceeds or otherwise.
