RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE A STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION AND OTHER MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission established by
2 chapter one hundred and forty of the resolves of nineteen hun-
3 dred and fifty-eight, revived and continued by chapter six of
4 the resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, and the time
5 for filing its final report extended by chapter one hundred and
6 eleven of the resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, shall,
7 in the course of its study, consider the subject matter of current
8 house document numbered 1909, relative to providing for the
9 elimination of a certain bridge on Morrissey boulevard in the
10 city of Quincy, and of current house document numbered 2158,
11 relative to providing for an advisory council of the metropolitan
12 district commission.
