RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF THE
TRANSFER OF THE BOARDS OF REGISTRATION IN MEDICINE, NURS-
ING AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC HEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That the legislative research council is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to investigate, study, consider and report
3 the possible transfer of the boards of registration in medicine,
4 nursing and other related matters from the department of civil
5 service and registration to the department of public health.
6 For the purpose of this resolve the legislative research council
7 may expend such sums as may be appropriated thereto. Said
8 legislative research council shall report its findings and recom-
9 mendations, if any, together with legislation to carry such rec-
10 ommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the
11 house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of
12 December, nineteen hundred and sixty.
