AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING LICENSING OF CAMPS, MOTELS AND TRAILER COACH PARKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 32H and inserting in place thereof the following
3 section: —

4 *Section 32H.* An applicant for a license under section thirty-
5 two B for a recreational camp, overnight camp or cabin, motel or
6 trailer coach park which has not been previously licensed, shall
7 file with the board plans showing the buildings, structures,
8 fixtures and facilities which he proposes to provide upon the
9 premises, if and when the license may issue. The board, after
10 a hearing as provided in section thirty-two B, and after approval
11 by the state department of public health of the plans of the
12 proposed water supply and sewage disposal facilities, and after
13 determination that the proposed recreational camp, overnight
14 camp or cabin, motel or trailer coach park will be in compliance
15 with all applicable laws, ordinances, rules and regulations, may
16 grant a license upon the condition that such license shall issue
17 upon the completion of the premises in accordance with the
18 plans and estimate submitted by the applicant and approved
19 by the board and the department of public health. Such license
20 may be suspended or revoked in accordance with the provisions
21 of sections thirty-two B and thirty-two C.
