RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE MASS TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ALTERING THE COMPOSITION OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND MAKING OTHER CHANGES THEREIN.

1 *Resolved*, That the mass transportation commission, estab-
2 lished under section nine of chapter sixteen of the General
3 Laws, is hereby authorized and directed to make an investi-
4 gation and study of the subject matter of current house docu-
5 ment numbered 2440, relative to altering the composition of the
6 Metropolitan Transit Authority and making other changes
7 therein. For the purposes of this resolve said commission may
8 expend such sums as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.
9 Said commission shall report to the general court the results of
10 its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,
11 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recom-
12 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the
13 senate on or before the last Wednesday of December in the cur-
14 rent year.
