AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FITCHBURG TO GRANT AN EASEMENT OVER, ACROSS AND UPON CERTAIN PARK LAND TO THE FITCHBURG GAS AND ELECTRIC LIGHT COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Fitchburg may sell and convey to
2 the Fitchburg Gas and Electric Light Company, a Massachu-
3 setts corporation with a usual place of business in Fitchburg,
4 for such price and on such terms as it may deem advisable, the
5 perpetual right and easement under, over, across and upon a
6 tract of land containing one hundred thousand square feet, more
7 or less, now under the jurisdiction of the Board of Park Com-
8 missioners and shown on a plan of the Fitchburg Gas and Elec-
9 tric Light Company, numbered F-1-3207, entitled "Right of
10 Way Across Land of City of Fitchburg Park Department".
11 The perpetual right and easement may include the following: —
12 1. To erect, relocate, rebuild and maintain one or more lines for
13 the transmission and distribution of high and low voltage elec-
14 tric current and lines for telephone use and such equipment and
15 apparatus as poles, structures or towers with necessary anchors.
16 2. To excavate for, lay, alter, operate, use and remove one or
17 more gas pipe lines with the suitable foundations, manholes,
18 equipment and appurtenances under the surface of said strip.
19 3. To pass along said strip to and from adjoining lands.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 vote of the city council and the board of park commissioners of
3 the city of Fitchburg.
