RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO REQUIRING SUMMONSES AND WARRANTS ISSUED BY DISTRICT COURTS TO SPECIFY THE CHAPTER AND SECTION OF THE GENERAL LAWS WHICH THE ACCUSED IS ALLEGED TO HAVE VIOLATED.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to investigate
2 the subject matter of current house document numbered 2123,
3 relative to requiring summonses and warrants issued by dis-
4 trict courts to specify the chapter and section of the General
5 Laws which the accused is alleged to have violated, and to in-
6 clude its conclusions and its recommendations, if any, in rela-
7 tion thereto, together with drafts of such legislation as may be
8 necessary to give effect to the same, in its annual report for the
9 current year.
