AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE STATUS OF BUILDINGS SITUATED ON LAND OF THE MARTHA'S VINEYARD CAMP MEETING ASSOCIATION IN OAK BLUFFS FOR PURPOSES OF THE OLD AGE ASSISTANCE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 All dwelling houses and other buildings erected on or affixed to  
2 the grounds of the Martha's Vineyard Camp Meeting Associa-  
3 tion, situated in the town of Oak Bluffs, which association was  
4 incorporated by chapter one hundred and seventy-six of the  
5 acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, shall, for the purposes  
6 of chapter one hundred and eighteen A of the General Laws, be  
7 considered real estate and the instruments creating liens set forth  
8 in section four of said chapter shall be recorded in accordance  
9 with the provisions of said section.
