AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR EXPERT ADVICE FOR THE COMMONWEALTH
IN THE DESIGN, INSTALLATION OR OPERATION OF POWER PLANTS
IN BUILDINGS UNDER ITS CONTROL.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose which is, in part, to immediately provide
3 expert advice to the commissioner of administration and finance
4 and to the institutions and departments of the commonwealth
5 relative to the design, installation or operation of power plants,
6 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, neces-
7 sary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 6 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 558 of the acts of 1951, is hereby further
3 amended by adding at the end the following: — The state pur-
4 chasing agent shall appoint one or more persons to act in an
5 advisory capacity to the division of building construction and
6 to the various institutions and departments of the common-
7 wealth relative to the design, installation or operation of power
8 plants. Each such appointee shall be registered as a profes-
9 sional engineer under the provisions of chapter one hundred and
10 twelve, and in addition thereto shall be licensed as a first class
11 engineer under the provisions of chapter one hundred and forty-
12 six and shall have specialized in the field of fuel and combustion
13 engineering. Such appointments shall not be subject to chapter
14 thirty-one.
