## The Commonwealth of Wassachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH TO THE PILGRIM SOCIETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The commissioner of public works, in the name of and on be-2 half of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized, subject to ap-3 proval by the governor and council, to sell and convey to the 4 Pilgrim Society, by a deed approved as to form by the attorney 5 general, all the right, title and interest of the commonwealth 6 in and to certain land situated in the town of Plymouth and de-7 scribed in a certain instrument recorded in the Plymouth county 8 registry of deeds, Book 1387, Page 99; provided, that said deed 9 shall provide (a) that all right, title and interest shall revert to 10 and revest in the commonwealth at any time said land ceases to 11 be used by said society for its purposes; and (b) that if the com-12 monwealth shall give said society one year's notice, by registered 13 mail, of its intention to take said land, and upon filing with said 14 registry of deeds notice of such taking, title to said land shall 15 immediately revest in the commonwealth, and the common-16 wealth shall not be liable in damages to said society by virtue
