## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE GRANTING WITHOUT EXAMINATION OF LICENSES AS ENGINEERS TO CERTAIN HOLDERS OF UNITED STATES MERCHANT MARINE ENGINEERING OFFICERS' LICENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 146 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-  
2 serting after section 50 the following section: —

3 *Section 50A.* Notwithstanding any contrary provision of this  
4 chapter, the holder of a valid United States merchant marine  
5 engineering officer's license as third assistant engineer of steam  
6 vessels of any horsepower, shall upon presentation of same, to-  
7 gether with proof of having served in the aforementioned  
8 capacity for a period of at least two years, be granted without  
9 examination, a third class engineer's license; the holder of a valid  
10 United States merchant marine engineering officer's license as  
11 second assistant engineer of steam vessels of any horsepower,  
12 shall upon presentation of same, together with proof of having  
13 served in the aforementioned capacity for a period of at least  
14 two years, be granted without examination, a second class en-  
15 gineer's license; the holder of a valid United States merchant  
16 marine engineering officer's license as either chief engineer or  
17 first assistant engineer of steam vessels of any horsepower, shall  
18 upon presentation of same, together with proof of having served  
19 in either of the aforementioned capacities for a period of at least  
20 two years, be granted without examination, a first class engineer's  
21 license.
