

Chap. 184. AN ACT MAKING FURTHER CORRECTIVE CHANGES IN THE LAW CHANGING THE FISCAL CYCLES OF COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS AND CERTAIN DISTRICTS.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make further corrective changes in the law changing the fiscal cycles of counties, cities, towns and certain districts, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 52 of the acts of 1973 is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and substituting in place thereof the following:— A school committee which excludes from its budget such estimated amounts shall either budget for the fiscal year commencing July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, the amounts necessary to make payments during the months of July and August, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, of monies earned by teachers and any other professional employees for the school year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, or budget for the fiscal year commencing July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, one-half of the amounts necessary to make payments during the months of July and August, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, of monies earned by teachers and any other professional employees for the school year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, and for the fiscal year commencing July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, the full amounts necessary to make payments during the months of July and August, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, of monies earned by teachers and any other professional employees for the school year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, and such amounts shall be subject to the provisions of section thirty-four of chapter seventy-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. Any action taken by a city, town, or regional school district subsequent to January first, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, pursuant to appropriations authorized by section one of this act shall be as valid and effective as though this act had been in full force and effect at the time of the initial action of the school committee.

Chap. 185. AN ACT EXTENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE OF A CERTAIN CIVIL SERVICE LIST.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith that there be at all times an established list of qualified candidates for the position of assistant civil engineer in the division of water resources in the department of natural resources, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency
