*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding any provision of the General Laws governing the expiration date of civil service lists, the list for the position of assistant civil engineer in the division of water resources in the department of natural resources established on November first, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, shall be revived and extended for a period not to exceed one year from the effective date of this act.

**Chap. 186.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF ESSEX AND THE PARK AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN TO EXPEND CERTAIN FUNDS FOR PRELIMINARY PLANNING FOR A RECREATION PROJECT IN THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Essex are hereby authorized to expend a sum of money, not exceeding ten thousand dollars, to be taken from the funds received by said county under the State and Local Fiscal Assistance Act of 1972 (Public Law 92-512) for the purpose of making preliminary plans for the development of the area commonly known as American Legion park in the town of Georgetown for a recreational area for the residents of said county in conjunction with the park and recreation commission of said town.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the town of Georgetown.

**Chap. 187.** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXAMINATION AND TREATMENT FOR VENEREAL DISEASE OF CERTAIN MINORS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The second paragraph of section 117 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, added by chapter 44 of the acts of 1954, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 2 and 3, the words "acting under the authority of the department of public health".
