AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXPENSES OF MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL COURT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for the payment
3 of additional expenses incurred by members of the general court
4 during the current session, therefore it is hereby declared to be
5 an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of
6 the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 In addition to any other compensation for expenses provided
2 by law, each member of the general court shall be paid the sum
3 of five hundred dollars for the calendar year nineteen hundred
4 and sixty for the additional expenses incurred by them during
5 the current session.
