

Chap. 10. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL COURT OFFICER IN THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first sentence of section 62 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 841 of the acts of 1969, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Norfolk", in line 28, the words: —, the first district court of Barnstable, *Approved February 8, 1971.*

Chap. 11. AN ACT DESIGNATING STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 53 IN THE TOWN OF HANOVER AS THE RICHARD CARDINAL CUSHING HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The state highway route 53 in the town of Hanover shall be known and designated as the Richard Cardinal Cushing highway, in memory of Richard Cardinal Cushing. Suitable markers bearing said designation shall be erected thereon by the department of public works in compliance with the standards of said department.

Chap. 12. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BEDFORD TO APPROPRIATE MONEY ANNUALLY IN ANTICIPATION OF THE CELEBRATION OF THE TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Bedford may appropriate money annually, from and including the year nineteen hundred and seventy to and including the year nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, for the celebration of the two hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the town of Bedford.

SECTION 2. Said town may establish in the town treasury a special fund in which shall be deposited such sums as may be appropriated by the town for said celebration. Any and all such sums received by the town treasurer shall be kept separate and apart from all other funds of the town and the principal and interest thereof may, from time to time, be expended for the purposes of said celebration by or upon the authorization of the board of selectmen. Any surplus remaining in said special fund after said celebration is concluded shall be transferred by said treasurer into the treasury of the town.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 13. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY CERTAIN CLUBS IN THE TOWN OF READING.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any limitations imposed by section eleven or eleven A of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws as to the time and manner of voting upon the questions
