AN ACT PROVIDING THAT REIMBURSEMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR COSTS OF CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS BE MADE IN THE FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH SAID COSTS ARE APPROPRIATED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The third paragraph of section 13 of chapter 71B of the
- 2 General Laws, inserted by section 11 of chapter 766 of the acts
- 3 of 1972, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:—
- 4 Such reimbursements shall be made to school committees in
- 5 the same fiscal year in which said committees appropriate
- 6 funds under section five.
