AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO BORROW MONEY OUTSIDE THE DEBT LIMIT FOR REGIONAL RECYLING FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out clause (18), as inserted by chapter
3 635 of the acts of 1969, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following clause: —

5 (18) For the construction of a regional incinerator or other
6 facility for the purpose of disposing of recycling solid waste,
7 refuse and garbage by two or more communities, twenty years,
8 but the indebtedness so incurred shall not exceed three per
9 cent of the last preceding equalized valuation of the city or
10 town and shall be subject to the approval of the emergency
11 finance board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
 Court assembled, and by the authority of the laws as follows:

- 1 Section 8 of chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out clause (18), as amended by chapter
- 3 433 of the acts of 1907, and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 4 following clause:—
- 5 (18) For the construction of a regional highway or other
- 6 facility for the purpose of disposing of treated solid waste;
- 7 signs and gauges by two or more communities jointly;
- 8 but the indebtedness so incurred shall not exceed three per
- 9 cent of the net proceeds realized within the city or
- 10 town and shall be subject to the approval of the emergency
- 11 board board.
