AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF OXFORD TO APPOINT ROBERT A. GILES TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to
2 the contrary, the board of selectmen of the town of Oxford
3 is hereby authorized to appoint as a permanent member of
4 the police department of said town, Robert A. Giles who has
5 been on the police provisional list of said town and has worked
6 as a provisional police officer, and who has passed the written
7 civil service examination for police officer and the physical
8 and strength test given prior to the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 2. Robert A. Giles shall upon such appointment
2 be entitled to all the privileges and benefits of chapter thirty-
3 one of the General Laws and shall be otherwise subject to said
4 chapter.
