AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTS BY MEMBERS OF THE
GENERAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of Chapter 268 A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the third paragraph thereof the
3 following paragraph:

4 (d) No member of the General Court shall represent a client
5 before any state department or agency for a fee.
