AN ACT PROVIDING FOR OVERTIME AND TRAVEL EXPENSE UNDER
CERTAIN CONDITIONS FOR CORRECTION OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Correction officers who are assigned a tour of duty at a pri-
- 2 vate, public or state hospital because of an inmate patient
- 3 shall receive additional compensation for time spent travelling
- 4 to and from such private, public or state hospital.
