By Mr. Walsh, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate No. 1253) of Joseph B. Walsh for legislation to reallocate positions in the division of apprenticeship training in the Department of Labor and Industries. Public Service.

AN ACT REALLOCATING POSITIONS IN THE DIVISION OF APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary,
- 2 the classifications of the following positions and job groups
- 3 in the division of apprenticeship training in the department of
- 4 labor and industry would be reclassified to the following
- 5 grades: —
- 6 apprentice training field representative to grade fifteen
- 7 senior field representative to grade seventeen
- 8 consultant, joint apprenticeship committees to grade seven-
- 9 teen
- 10 supervisory apprentice training field representative to grade
- 11 eighteen
- 12 administrative assistant to the director of apprenticeship to
- 13 grade nineteen
- 14 director of apprenticeship to grade twenty-two

By Mr. Wainwright a bill was introduced by title number 1225 to amend the laws relating to the Department of Labor and Industry, to read as follows:
