AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISPOSITION OF FUNDS ALLOCATED TO HOUSING  
AUTHORITIES FOR PUBLIC SAFETY PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 121 B of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after Section 26 as amended by Chapter  
3 694 Acts of 1970, the following section: —

4 *Section 26C.* Any sums appropriated by the commonwealth  
5 for public safety purposes to housing authorities may be used  
6 by police agencies established by them.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon passage.

- 6 by public agencies established by them.
