

**Chap. 334.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOSTON JUVENILE COURT TO SIT OUTSIDE THE SUFFOLK COUNTY COURT HOUSE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 3 of chapter 489 of the acts of 1906 is hereby amended by adding after the word "house", in line 14, the words:— ; provided, however, that the court may sit in such other suitable place within its territorial jurisdiction as the court may determine.

**Chap. 335.** AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN OPERATORS OF A MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT OF WAY WHEN MAKING LEFT TURNS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 14 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the next to the last sentence, as appearing in chapter 166 of the acts of 1957, the following sentence:— When turning to the left within an intersection or into an alley, private road or driveway an operator shall yield the right of way to any vehicle approaching from the opposite direction which is within the intersection or so close thereto as to constitute an immediate hazard.

**Chap. 336.** AN ACT DESIGNATING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION PLAYGROUND TO BE CONSTRUCTED ON THE NEPONSET VALLEY PARKWAY IN THE HYDE PARK DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE JOSEPH A. DeSANTIS PLAYGROUND.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The children's playground to be constructed by the metropolitan district commission on Neponset Valley parkway in the Hyde Park district of the city of Boston shall upon completion be designated and known as the Joseph A. DeSantis playground, in memory of Joseph A. DeSantis, who was killed during World War II while serving as a member of the armed forces of the United States. A suitable marker bearing such designation shall be erected thereat by said commission.
