The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO OTHER COMPENSATION A MEMBER OF THE  
LEGISLATIVE BODY OF A CITY CAN RECEIVE FROM THE CITY.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to allow members of the legislative body of a city to officiate at sporting events for compensation, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first sentence of section 6A of Chapter 29 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in section 1 of Chapter 72 of the acts of  
3 1958, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "city", in  
4 line 6, the words: — ; provided, however, that any compen-  
5 sation received for part time officiating of city sponsored sport-  
6 ing events shall not be subject to this section.
