

**Chap. 10.** AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY MAY EXPEND FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADVERTISING THE RECREATIONAL, CULTURAL, HISTORICAL AND SCENIC ADVANTAGES OF SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter seventeen of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-eight is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The county commissioners of Worcester county may, for the purpose of advertising and promoting the recreational, cultural, historic and scenic advantages of said county, expend such sums, not exceeding, in the aggregate, seventy-five thousand dollars in any one year, as may be appropriated therefor; provided, that such expenditures from money so appropriated shall not at any time be more than triple the sum which shall have been contributed by public subscription or by donation and deposited with the county treasurer for the purpose aforesaid. Said commissioners shall expend such sums only for advertising and promotion in newspapers, magazines, and the like, or for booklets, posters, or other forms of advertising and promotion, or for information booths within the county, or for displays or booths maintained at fairs, expositions, or travel shows outside the county for the purpose of advertising such advantages, or for the processing of inquiries resulting from such promotional activities. In carrying out the provisions of this act the commissioners may designate the Central Massachusetts Tourist Council, Inc. as an agent to act for them; provided, that all bills incurred shall be accompanied by proper vouchers and shall be paid by the county treasurer only on warrants approved by the county commissioners or a majority of them.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 11.** AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WHICH THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BERKSHIRE COUNTY MAY EXPEND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE RECREATIONAL ADVANTAGES OF SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Berkshire county may, for the purpose of advertising the recreational advantages of said county, expend such sums, not exceeding, in the aggregate, sixty thousand dollars in any one year, as may be appropriated therefor; provided, that such expenditures from money so appropriated shall not at any time be more than triple the sum which shall have been contributed by public subscription or by donation deposited with the county treasurer for the purpose aforesaid. Said commissioners shall expend such sums only for advertising in newspapers, magazines and the like, or for booklets, posters or other forms of advertising, or for information booths within the county, or for displays of booths maintained at fairs, expositions or travel shows outside the county for the purpose of
