RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO THE DREDGING OF DORCHESTER BAY.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 of the subject matter of current senate document numbered
4 584, providing for the dredging of Dorchester Bay. Said
5 department shall report to the general court the results of its
6 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
9 of the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday
10 of December in the current year.
