AN ACT TO PERMIT A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO TERMINATE ACCEPTANCE OF THE LAW PROVIDING LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE FOR RETIRED TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eleven E of chapter thirty-two-B of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the fol-
3 lowing paragraph; —

4 A political subdivision that has accepted this section and
5 whose application has been approved by the commission as
6 provided in section thirteen of chapter thirty-two-A may
7 thereafter terminate its acceptance of this section. Such
8 termination shall take effect by a vote obtained in the same
9 manner as that required for an acceptance of this section.
10 Such political subdivision shall thereafter furnish notice of
11 each vote to the commission.
