AN ACT RELATIVE TO CAREER INCENTIVE PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 41, section 108L is hereby amended
2 by adding after the words "metropolitan district commission
3 police" the following: — and state correction officers.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 41, section 108L is amended by adding
2 at the end of paragraph one the following words: — or law
3 enforcement work.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter 41, section 108L is hereby further
2 amended by adding in the first sentence of the fourth para-
3 graph after the words "police officers" and before the word
4 "shall" the words: — or correction officers, parole officers,
5 director of parole services, chief parole supervisor, parole
6 supervisor, employment officer, parole board, parole officer.
