By Mr. Burke, a petition, (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 714) of Edward L. Burke for legislation to limit the amount of excess monthly income that a recipient or beneficiary of financial assistance shall be liable to pay to the provider of medical care or services. AN ACT LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF EXCESS MONTHLY INCOME THAT A RECIPIENT OR BENEFICIARY OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SHALL BE LIABLE TO PAY TO THE PROVIDER OF MEDICAL CARE OR SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of Chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the fourth paragraph, and inserting
3 in place thereof the following paragraph:—

4 In any case where the monthly income of a recipient or ben-
5 eficiary is in excess of the exemptions allowed, the recipient or
6 beneficiary shall be liable to pay to the provider of medical
7 care or service an amount which shall be equal to 50% of the
8 excess income for a period of six months, which includes the
9 period when such service was provided.
