AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN INMATES FROM BRINGING CERTAIN ARTICLES INTO CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS UPON RETURN FROM FURLOUGH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 268 of the General Laws, Section 31, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after said section the following section:
3 *Section 31A.* Any inmate of a correctional institution
4 who is granted a furlough and, upon returning from such
5 furlough, brings or attempts to bring into said institution a
6 gun, knife or other similar lethal or dangerous weapon, shall
7 be punished by an additional sentence of not less than seven
8 years or more than ten years in state prison.
