- 6 the commonwealth shall reimburse the cost of any such pro-
- 7 grams dealing with problems of the aging, at a rate to be de-
- 8 termined by the secretary of the executive office of elder af-
- 9 fairs. Each council on the aging shall annually submit to said
- 10 secretary reports of monies expended and descriptions of the
- 11 programs established.
