By Mr. Bernashe, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1028) of Roger L. Bernashe for legislation to authorize free admission and parking for members of the National Guard at certain state parks. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING FREE ADMISSION AND PARKING FOR MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD AT CERTAIN STATE PARKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 132A of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 7 the following section: —

3 *Section 7A.* All members of the active national guard, army
4 or air, of the commonwealth and members of their immediate
5 families who, upon furnishing proof of membership in said
6 national guard as provided by the adjutant general of the
7 commonwealth, shall be admitted and permitted to park at no
8 cost in all state parks under the direction and control of the
9 department of natural resources and metropolitan district
10 commission.

11 This act shall in no way grant privileges to such member
12 and his immediate family which are contrary to the policy of
13 first come first served, so-called, which may be in force by
14 such department or commission.
