AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO BORROW MONEY OUTSIDE THE DEBT LIMIT FOR REGIONAL RECYCLING FACILITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 8 of chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out clause (18), as inserted by chapter  
3 635 of the acts of 1969, and inserting in place thereof the fol-  
4 lowing clause: —

5 (18) For the construction of a regional solid waste facility  
6 for the purpose of disposing of or recycling solid waste, refuse  
7 and garbage by two or more communities, twenty years, but  
8 the indebtedness so incurred shall not exceed three percent of  
9 the last preceding equalized valuation of the city or town and  
10 shall be subject to the approval of the emergency finance  
11 board.
