

and eleven of the General Laws, as amended by section one of this act, shall commence not more than forty-five days from the effective date of this act and the initial amendments to the standards and plan of implementation shall be adopted on or before October first, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.

Chap. 495. AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH THE ELIGIBLE LIST FOR THE POSITION OF NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL BE EFFECTIVE.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is, to provide forthwith that there be at all times an established eligible list of qualified candidates for the position of natural resources officer in the department of natural resources, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the eligible list for appointment to the position of natural resources officer in the department of natural resources, established on August eighteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, shall be revived and extended for a period not to exceed one year from the effective date of this act.

Chap. 496. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN TO APPROPRIATE AND PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO FELIX CARLINO.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Franklin is hereby authorized to appropriate money for the payment of, and after such appropriation the treasurer of said town is hereby authorized to pay, the sum of one thousand seventy-six dollars and thirty-two cents to Felix Carlino, director of public works in said town, for services rendered to said town in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, during which period said Felix Carlino was unable to take his vacation leave as he was required to work during said vacation by the board of public works.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
